Vocabulary- This chapter has extensive vocabulary. You must <u>be able to identify</u> all of the following:

Zealots-Galillee centered, Jewish freedom fighters against Rome Essenes-Jewish separatists who sought purity of life by going into desert. Pharisees-Jewish middle class, overemphasized rules and regulations, belief

in all OT books of Bible, angels, and resurrection of dead.

Criticized by Jesus for hypocrisy and living by "letter of the Law" **Scribes-** Group within Pharisees-students of Law, religious lawyers

Saducees-Jewish priestly class. Wealthy and influential. Only priests could make sacrifices in Temple. Cooperated with Romans. Only accepted Torah and did not believe in angels or resurrection.

Samaritans- Hated by Jews and considered heretics (followers of false religious teachings). Samaritans were former Jews who had intermarried with foreigners. Samaria and Samaritans were avoided by Jews.

Gentiles- Non Jews-Romans were gentiles. All gentiles were despised and avoided by Jews.

Torah- First five books of the Bible-known as "The Law" to Jews.

Herod"the Great"- King apponted by Romans at time of Jesus's Birth. Rebuilt the Temple with incredible magnificence.

Aramaic- Language spoken by Jesus everyday

Sanhedrin- Jewish religious court or council of 72 men. Led by High Priest and included sadducees and pharisees.

Synagogue- Local houses of prayer for Jews in towns and villages. Torah was read and studied here.
