

SADDUCEES

Accepted only the first 5 books of the Old Testament as inspired

PHARISEES

Accepted the Torah, the Prophets, and Other Writings, plus their own oral traditions, as God's word

Accepted the

doctrine of the

resurrection of

JESUS "

Accepted the Hebrew scriptures, but interpreted them in an original way

Denied the doctrine of the resurrection of the body

Denied that angels.exist

Strict code of justice: "Eye for eye, tooth for tooth."

Believed in angels

More liberal code of justice. Hillel taught: "What is hateful to you, do not do it unto your neighbor."

Believed in the resurrection: "I am the resurrection" (Jn 11:25)

Believed in angels

Taught love of enemy and the Golden Rule: "So always treat others as you would like them to treat you" (Mt 7:12)

Strong emphasis on human freedom Strong emphasis on God's control over human affairs Strong emphasis on a caring, loving God who wants us to use freedom properly

Cooperated with the Romans

Hated the Romans Forgave his enemies and taught respect for everyone
