

School Supply-Additional Notes

Kindergarten

Additional Notes:

1. Each child will need a large, oversized T-shirt for Art. Send the shirt in a large, zippered bag with the child's name and class on both the shirt and on the bag. Ensure that your child can put the shirt on independently.
2. Each child will need a regular-sized, rectangular beach towel for use during rest time. Please label the towel with your child's name.
3. Please plan on using a backpack that is large enough to hold all writing supplies, folders, and lunchboxes. We do not allow backpacks with wheels.
4. Cubby can: Each child will need a cubby can, which may be made from a clean, empty cake frosting container, to hold their daily supplies. Please decorate the can with the child's name and colors, stickers, or pictures that your child prefers. This should be brought to school on the first day of school.
5. Special note regarding crayons: Only 8 basic colors (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, brown, and black) will be kept in the cubby cans. Send one box of the 8-count crayons on the first day of school and keep the other boxes at home for replacements during the school year.
6. All crayons, markers, and colored pencils must have the words AP or CP non-toxic printed on the box.
7. Please label headphones and send in a large, zippered bag with the child's name on the bag. Write your child's name on a piece of masking tape or a paper label and tape them to the headphones as well. Please make sure that the headphones are sized correctly to your child's ears and head.

First Grade

Additional Notes:

1. Each child will need a large, oversized T-shirt for Art. Send the shirt in a large, zippered bag with the child's name on both the shirt and on the bag. Ensure that your child can put the shirt on independently.
2. Please keep these items handy for use at home:
 - Con-Tac clear covering (enough to cover 10 workbooks)
 - a box of envelopes to send forms to school as needed
 - a pencil sharpener
 - a black, Sharpie marker to label workbooks and supplies.
3. Please bring all paper towels, disinfectant wipes, sanitizer, baby wipes, and tissues to the first-grade parent orientation. Details on this orientation will follow.
4. Each Friday, students will bring home supply boxes. Please check the supplies and make sure that 8 sharpened pencils are returned each week. Please DO NOT send in mechanical pencils or pencil sharpeners.
5. Each week, check to make sure that 8 basic colors (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, brown, and black) of crayons are still available in the supply box. Replace as needed.
6. All students are required to have a sturdy backpack labeled with the student's name. We do not allow backpacks with wheels.
7. All crayons, markers, and colored pencils must have the words AP or CP non-toxic printed on the box.
8. Please label headphones and send in a large, zippered bag with the child's name on the bag. Write your child's name on a piece of masking tape or a paper label and tape them to the headphones as well. Please make sure that the headphones are sized correctly to your child's ears and head. Please do not send in earbuds.
8. Please label all uniform pieces, jackets, and lunch boxes.
9. All workbooks must be labeled with the student name written in black marker and then covered with Con-Tac paper.

Second Grade

Additional Notes:

1. Each child will need a large, oversized T-shirt for Art. Send the shirt in a large, zippered bag with the child's name on both the shirt and on the bag.
2. Please keep these items handy for use at home:
 - Con-Tac clear covering (enough to cover 7 workbooks and 6 composition books)
 - a box of envelopes to send forms to school as needed
 - a pencil sharpener
 - a black, Sharpie marker to label workbooks and supplies.
 - extra glue sticks
3. Please bring all paper towels, disinfectant wipes, sanitizer pump, baby wipes, and tissues on the first day of school.
4. Each Friday, students will bring their supply boxes home. Please check the supplies and sharpen all the pencils for the return to school. Only regular pencils are for classroom use. The mechanical pencils will be donated to the music classroom.
5. All students are required to have a sturdy backpack labeled with the student's name. We do not allow backpacks with wheels.
6. All crayons, markers, and colored pencils must have the words AP or CP non-toxic printed on the box.
7. Please label earbuds with a paper label or strip of masking tape. Send in the earbuds in a small, zippered bag labeled with your child's name.
8. Please label all uniform pieces, jackets, and lunch boxes.
9. All workbooks must be labeled with the student name written in black marker and then covered with Con-Tac paper.

2. Please bring all supplies, paper towels, disinfectant wipes, sanitizer pump, baby wipes, and tissues on the first day of school.
3. All labeling and set-up of folders, accordion folders, and notebooks will be completed in class.
4. Please do not send in mechanical pencils, erasable pens, or pens that click.
5. All students are required to have a sturdy backpack labeled with the student's name. We do not allow backpacks with wheels.
6. All crayons, markers, and colored pencils must have the words AP or CP non-toxic printed on the box.
7. Please label earbuds with a paper label or strip of masking tape. Send in the earbuds in a small, zippered bag labeled with your child's name.
8. Please label all supplies with your child's name. In addition, please label all uniform pieces, jackets, and lunch boxes.
9. All workbooks must be labeled with the student name written in black marker and then covered with Con-Tac paper.
10. Hardcover textbooks must be covered with brown paper, white paper, or a book sox (3 are included in the kit). Please do not cover textbooks with Con-Tac clear covering. Student name and subject should be written on the book cover.

5. All crayons, markers, and colored pencils must have the words AP or CP non-toxic printed on the box.
6. Please label earbuds with a paper label or strip of masking tape. Send in the earbuds in a small, zippered bag labeled with your child's name.
7. Please label all supplies, folders, and composition books with your child's name. In addition, please label all uniform pieces, jackets, and lunch boxes.
8. All workbooks must be labeled with the student name written in black marker and then covered with Con-Tac paper.
9. Hardcover textbooks must be covered with brown paper, white paper, or a book sox. Please do not cover textbooks with Con-Tac clear covering. Student name and subject should be written on the book cover.
10. **Please DO NOT purchase a spiral-bound flexi-view organizer.**
11. Label the 6-pocket folder with the student's name.
12. Label the 6 marble composition books (in 5 different colors, if possible) with the student's name and as follows:
 - Blue: Math
 - Blue: Library
 - Black: English
 - Black: Literature
 - Red: Science
 - Green: Social Studies
 - Purple: Religion
13. Label the white, 1-inch binder with the student's name and "Spanish".
14. Insert some loose-leaf paper into the pronged music folder.
15. Please do not send in white-out tape or white-out liquid.
